

6th Grade Supply List

Dear Future 6th Graders,

The 6th grade teachers would like to officially welcome you to 6th grade! We have compiled a list of materials that we would like you to bring on the first day of school. You will need these materials all year long. **Most of these supplies must be replaced periodically throughout the school year!** Please **DO NOT** purchase a planner for your child. One will be provided by the middle school.

For All Classes:

- 2 boxes of #2 pencils
- 3 highlighters (one pink, one yellow, one green)
- 1 set of fine-tipped markers (such as Crayola)
- 2 correcting pens (such as red, green or purple)
- Loose-leaf paper (wide-ruled)
- 1 personal binder or organizer with 4 sections or folders for academic classes
- 1 box of tissues
- 3 pads of 3 x 5 sticky notes
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 4 glue sticks



Language Arts:

- 1 composition book/journals (9.75 x 7.5"/wide ruled)
- 2 ultra-fine Sharpies (black)
- 1 white, 1 ½ inch view-binder (clear front pocket on cover)

Math:

- 1 composition book/journal (9.75 x 7.5"/wide ruled)
- 1 package dry-erase markers (no neon colors)



Science:

- 1 spiral-bound notebook
- 2 or more large rolls of Scotch tape (to put in a dispenser)
- 2 or more clean, empty 2 liter bottles

Social Studies:

- 1 spiral-bound notebook
- 1 package of dry-erase markers

Optional Supplies:

- magnets for locker

PE:

- appropriate clothing, no street shoes

For Use at Home:

- 1 inexpensive solar 4-function calculator



All materials need to be marked with your name. Larger items such as notebooks and calculators definitely need to have your name on them, but even smaller items such as pencils last longer with your name.

We do not allow book bags or backpacks in the classroom. They should be small enough to fit in a locker (locker size: 9" wide, 10 ½" deep, and 34" tall).

7th grade supply list

The following supplies are needed at the beginning of the year:

- " 24 #2 pencils – **be sure to replace as needed**
- " Loose leaf paper, wide ruled - **replace as needed**
- " 4 folders with pockets – **one folder for each core class**
- " 4 glue sticks– **give to Block 1 teacher**
- " 3 large boxes of Kleenex – **give to Block 1 teacher**
- " colored pencils
- " Highlighters – **be sure to have at least 1 green, 1 pink, 1 yellow and 1 blue**
- " pencil pouch – **labeled with your name**
- " Locker shelf – **not required but very helpful.**
- " 4 spiral notebooks
- " 8 Dry Erase Markers
- Dividers for binders
- Erasers or Pencil top erasers
- 3 three-ring binders
- Black and Blue Pen

This is a list of minimal basic supplies. Supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year. Student planners will be given to all students to use regularly throughout the school year. Lost planners will need to be replaced at student expense.

Other supplies which will be needed during the school year:

- P.E. --
 - Shorts (at least 6 in. inseam length), T-shirt with sleeves, shoes, sweatshirt, sweatpants - all labeled with name
- Band:
 - Flutes - Cleaning rod and cloth
 - Clarinet and Saxes - Four reeds, cleaning swabs, reed guard
 - Trumpet, Tuba, Baritone - Valve oil, cleaning cloths, cleaning snake, tuning slide grease
 - Trombones - Slide cream, water spray bottle, cleaning snake and cloth, slide grease
 - Snare Drum - Sticks and bell mallets
- Unified Arts classes may require other supplies
 - Additional supplies may be needed based on classroom placement

BACK PACKS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE CLASSROOM. THEY SHOULD BE SMALL ENOUGH TO FIT IN A LOCKER.

8th GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2017-2018

General Supplies:

- Spiral Notebooks (single subject and multiple subject)
- Pencils
- One large box of Kleenex
- Flash Drive
- Other supplies may be needed during the year for special projects.
- **Supplies will need to be replenished on an "as needed" basis.** Many of these supplies will NOT be used until later in the year. Students will be responsible for having these available when needed.

For Language Arts:

- Journal Notebook (composition notebook is perfect)
- 3-ring binder
- Loose leaf paper
- A few dry erase markers

For Math:

- Basic calculators for math (if you would like to buy a graphing calculator; TI-83 plus or higher models will work all the way through high school - **for those who will take Algebra I in 8th grade, it is highly recommended that you purchase one of these**)
- At least 5 Black dry erase markers (you will use these every day, so you may have to repurchase throughout the year)
- Pack of loose leaf quadrille ($\frac{1}{4}$ ") graphing paper
- Straight edge ruler with imperial & metric markings

For Science:

- 3-ring loose leaf binder, 1-in, with some loose leaf notebook paper
